

REACH SVHC STATEMENT

Lithoz GmbH as manufacturer of ceramic slurries for LCM based additive manufacturing is obliged to follow current regulations regarding Registration, Evaluation, Authorization and Restriction of Chemicals (REACH 1907/2006) in the EU.

Since no substance is exceeding 1 ton per year as defined under article 7(1) Lithoz GmbH is not required to register.

No substances are in use that are restricted or would require an authorization as described in article 56 and 67.

According to the obligation to inform according to article 33 we state that **none of the so called "Candidate List" Substances of Very High Concern (SVHCs) at >0.1% w/w or substances of Annex XIV("Authorisation List") are present in our materials** including the commercially available ceramic slurries, cleaning fluids (LithaSol) and primers (LithaPrime).

It has to be stated that this declaration is based on the materials as delivered to the customer. The use of any additional materials during the additive manufacturing process by the customer may alter the composition. Such influences are not within Lithoz's responsibility and not within the scope of this declaration.

This statement refers to current REACH regulations and is not intended to be seen as statement in context of any other, especially but not limited to medical device regulations for CMR (carcinogenic, mutagenic or toxic for reproduction) evaluation.
